

# EAST MARLBOROUGH TOWNSHIP

## BOARD OF SUPERVISORS

Meeting of the Board – July 7, 2008

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Chairman Cuyler H. Walker called the public meeting to order at 7:30 p.m. in the Township Building by leading the group in the pledge to the United States Flag. Board Members Richard E. Hicks and Robert F. Weer were also present, as was Solicitor Fronfield Crawford, Jr.

**Minutes of June 2, 2008.** By unanimous vote (3-0), the minutes were approved as prepared.

**Public Comment Period.** There were no public comments.

### **Escrow Releases.**

**Glenelg Farm** - Rob Pearson represented the development requesting the release of \$23,235 in escrowed funds; the Board approved the release by unanimous vote (3-0).

**Pennock Green** - Chadd Marks was present, requesting the release of \$16,050. The Board approved the request by unanimous vote (3-0).

**Schoolhouse Lane – Bentley.** Doug Knox was present, requesting the final release of \$288,438. The Board voted unanimously (3-0) to release the funds, subject to response regarding completion of the landscaping and sewer facilities from GTP and URS, respectively.

**Request for Temporary closure of Route 82.** Unionville High School student Kevin Manning requested permission to close Route 82 to traffic from the Elementary School to the High School on September 27, 2008, from 11 until 11:45 a.m. for a Homecoming Parade. The Board voted unanimously (3-0), to approve the request, subject to proper coverage of the points of access to the closed portion of the road.

**Kennett Senior Center.** Karen Halsted presented a request for municipal funding for the Center in Kennett, which she reported, served 1800 East Marlborough residents last year. Because the funding for the center has been cut back, the Center is seeking support from each of the 13 municipalities served by the Center. The Board pledged to consider the request at budget time, but requested information on the plans of other municipalities to contribute funds.

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**Route 82 South Sewer Project.** The Supervisors discussed the status of the New Sewer District, including projected fees, time schedule for construction as well as individual residential connection.

**Resolution 08-12.** By unanimous vote (3-0), the Supervisors approved a resolution noting that the Board of Supervisors intends to proceed with plans to construct the Route 82 Sewer System, in accordance with the design and specifications produced by the Township’s consulting engineers, URS Corporation, and acknowledging that the Board of Supervisors is authorized to accept a qualifying bid for construction of the Route 82 South Area Collection system.

**Route 82/Route One Overpass Intersection Improvements.** Traffic Planning and Design submitted a proposal for additional fees of \$3,800 to complete the plans for the above-referenced project. By unanimous vote (3-0), the Board approved the additional design work.

**Road Bid.** By unanimous vote (3-0), the Board accepted the low bid of Asphalt Industries totaling approximately \$22,572, to perform surface treatments on various roads for the 2008 season.

**Bills.** By unanimous vote (3-0), the Board approved payment of the attached list of invoices, with the following totals:
